It is an intensive therapy for neurological disorders like cerebral palsy, traumatic brain injuries and other conditions which affect the child's motor and cognitive functions. Children wear a soft dynamic orthotic which consists of a cap, vest, shorts, kneepads and special adapted shoes that are interconnected with elastic bands. The PediaSuit creates a supporting unit to align the body as close to normal as possible, reestablishing correct postural alignment and weight bearing which is fundamental in normalizing muscle tone, sensory and vestibular function.

Additionally, for children diagnosed with autism we offer in-home services, school consultation, advocacy and parent training.
